We are very excited to provide a new learning experience for your child. UNC-Chapel Hill's Morehead Planetarium and Science Center will provide science education programming at your child's school this semester.

To prepare for the visit, please review and complete the attached form.

The release form, required for many UNC programs, is designed to support the safety of minor children during Morehead activities. Also, the release form includes a photo release. If you do not want your child to be photographed, please write, "No photos" on the form below your signature. This consent form <u>must</u> be correctly filled out and signed for your child to participate in the experience.

Morehead's *Lab to Life* program is a selection of interactive lessons for middle and high school students. Students will take on the role of a scientist performing an everyday task or investigation that they might do as part of their job. Through chemistry- or biology-focused labs, students will have a chance to experience what it would be like to work in a variety of STEM careers and see the direct application of the skills and standards they are learning in their classes.

As a result of this unique time, we have added extra safety precautions to our program. Morehead staff will wear face coverings during the program, increase cleaning and disinfecting practices, and design activities that encourage completing activities individually instead of working in groups as much as possible.

Since many people are unfamiliar with Morehead programming, I hope this information is interesting and helpful as you discuss the experience with your child.
