Hiring Teachers for Summer Camps

The GSK Science in the Summer program in North Carolina is recruiting *teachers to lead week-long science enrichment programs at libraries and community-based centers in Alamance, Chatham, Durham, Franklin, Granville, Harnett, Johnston, Orange, Vance, and Wake counties during summer 2022. (*Certified teachers are preferred.)

All science program educators will be trained on how to use GSK's biology curriculum developed for its GSK Science in the Summer™ program, along with hands-on activities from Morehead Planetarium and Science Center's summer program curricula.

Types of Camps

Level I/II (rising 2nd-5th grade)

- Monday-Friday
- 20 students per session
- Morning: 2nd and 3rd grades
- Afternoon: 4th and 5th grades
- Hours range from 9 a.m. 4 p.m.

Level III (rising 6th-8th grade)

- · Three-day, half-day
- 24 students per session
- Hours are either 9 a.m.–12 p.m. or 1 p.m.–4 p.m. (depending on site)

Requirements

An interview with Morehead staff will be required for final applicants/candidates on either Saturday, March 5 or Saturday, March 12 depending upon your assigned date and time.

Science program educators are required to attend either a training session on either Saturday, June 4 (Level III) and/or Saturday, June 11 (Level I/II) in Chapel Hill where they will learn how to deliver the Science in the Summer curriculum. The training date(s) will depend on the type of camp you are assigned.

Employment is contingent upon a criminal background check and your availability to attend and complete the mandatory paid training sessions which will be assigned based on your program location/site. Hiring preference will be extended to certified teachers, those with Morehead program experience, and those who teach or attend school in SIS counties.
