Requirements

All educators must be certified teachers.

An interview with Morehead staff will be required for final applicants/ candidates in April in Gates County.

Science program educators are **required** to attend a training session in June in Gates County where they will learn how to deliver the Science in the Summer curriculum.

Employment is contingent upon a criminal background check and your availability to attend and complete the mandatory paid training session.
