Morehead Planetarium and Science Center at UNC-Chapel Hill is the proud founder and producer of the annual, month-long North Carolina Science Festival (NCSciFest). Launched in 2010, **NCSciFest was the first statewide celebration of science in the United States**, and it continues to be one of the largest events of its kind in the nation. Since its founding, NCSciFest has reached more than 3,686,303 participants from all 100 North Carolina counties.

NCSciFest works with community partners across the state to host events **throughout the month of April** in locations that include K-16 schools, libraries, museums, parks, and science centers. From science nights to engineering competitions to science expos to skywatching parties, NCSciFest events engage participants with science in fun and welcoming settings. Event hosts cultivate positive environments that encourage children and teens to see themselves as scientists and spark people's interest in science and science-related career pathways.

In 2026, NCSciFest will celebrate the everyday impact of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) on the lives of people that call North Carolina home.



The **UNC Science Expo** is a signature event of NCSciFest and one of the biggest celebrations of science in the state. Morehead partners with faculty and students at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to share their research with the community in a festival-like atmosphere.

Each year the Expo welcomes between **8,000-10,000 visitors** from the Triangle region and beyond to campus. More than 120 booths staffed by researchers, students, and other science-loving volunteers fill the quads surrounding Morehead. From hands-on activities and games to science demonstrations and behind-the-scenes lab tours, the Expo makes learning about science fun and engaging for people of all ages.
