The GSK Science in the Summer™ program is recruiting high school students to work as assistants during week-long science programs at libraries and community-based centers in Alamance, Chatham, Durham, Franklin, Granville, Harnett, Johnston, Orange, Vance, and Wake counties during summer 2020.

What you'll do

You'll work alongside a certified teacher to lead science camp sessions for elementary and/or middle school students. Students will participate in hands-on experiments such as the chemistry of diapers and zombie worms.

Level I/II programs (for elementary school students) are held in both the morning and afternoons with hours ranging from 9 a.m.–4 p.m.; you'll receive a 45-minute lunch break depending on the program location.

Level III programs (for middle school students) are half-day and take place at either 9 a.m.–12 p.m. or 1 p.m.–4 p.m. depending on the program location.

What is it?

- Complete training on May 30 AND/OR Jun. 6 (based on the camp)
