Keynote speaker: **Dr. Luiz Pimenta** grew up in Brazil, where he attended a military school until the age of seventeen. With dreams of becoming a dentist like his father, he went to dental school. After running a successful dental practice, Dr. Pimenta decided to pursue his love of teaching and became a professor of restorative dentistry. He came to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 2004 as a visiting professor, only planning to stay in the United States for a year. When offered a permanent position in the Adams School of Dentistry at UNC Chapel Hill, he made the difficult decision to move his family to the U.S. and has been here ever since! Dr. Pimenta is currently a professor of Prosthodontics and has traveled around the world to help children with cleft palate. In addition to teaching and traveling, Dr. Pimenta brings dentists from across the globe to UNC to receive U.S. training alongside American students.
