Hiring Teachers for Summer Camps

The GSK Science in the Summer program in North Carolina is recruiting educators to lead science enrichment programs at a Gates County public school during summer 2022.

All science program educators will be trained to use GSK’s biology curriculum and other STEM activities developed for its GSK Science in the Summer™ program, along with hands-on activities from Morehead Planetarium and Science Center’s summer program curricula.

Requirements

An interview with Morehead staff will be required for final applicants/candidates in April in Gates County.

Science program educators are required to attend a training session in June in Gates County where they will learn how to deliver the Science in the Summer curriculum.

Employment is contingent upon a criminal background check and your availability to attend and complete the mandatory paid training session.
