MOREHEAD PLANETARIUM AND SCIENCE CENTER

Morehead Planetarium—now Morehead Planetarium and Science Center—was **dedicated in 1949** as a powerful tool for the education of North Carolinians. It was the first planetarium in the world built on a college campus and only the eighth planetarium built in the United States. Over the past 75 years, millions of North Carolina students, teachers, and families as well as visitors from around the world have benefitted from its innovative science programming.

True to its founding mission, Morehead continues to bring together the unique resources of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to engage the public for an enhanced understanding of science. It partners with scientists to develop outstanding planetarium shows, interactive exhibits, hands-on classes, camps, and other programs that allow visitors to experience the wonder of science. It shows people why science matters and how research happening today will change lives tomorrow.

In addition to providing an exceptional visitor experience, Morehead is committed to expanding access and opportunity by delivering educational programming to schools and communities across the state. Outreach efforts range from school-based science programs to targeted student enrichment opportunities to public engagement events. Morehead educators help bring science to life, with exciting and inspiring programs designed to engage young and old alike. Morehead's outreach programs are the embodiment of its commitment to achieving Science for All.

NORTH CAROLINA SCIENCE FESTIVAL

Morehead is the proud founder and producer of the annual, month-long North Carolina Science Festival (NCSciFest). Launched in 2010, **NCSciFest was the first statewide celebration of science in the United States**, and it continues to be one of the largest events of its kind in the nation. Since its founding, NCSciFest has reached more than 3.5 million participants from all 100 North Carolina counties.

NCSciFest works with community partners across the state to host events **throughout the month of April** in locations that include K-12 schools, libraries, museums, parks, and science centers. From science nights to engineering competitions to science expos to skywatching parties, NCSciFest events provide participants with opportunities to engage with science in fun and welcoming settings. Event hosts cultivate positive environments that encourage children and teens to see themselves as scientists and spark people's interest in science knowledge and career pathways.

In 2024, NCSciFest will highlight North Carolina's academic and industrial prominence in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) through the theme **State of Innovation**.



HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2022-2023

MOREHEAD PLANETARIUM AND SCIENCE CENTER

More than 75,000 people visited Morehead to see planetarium shows, exhibits, or other programs, including 30,000 field trip participants More than 38,000 students from 478 schools received educational programming from Morehead, including 4,200 students who experienced the mobile planetarium

Almost 1,000 students attended on-site summer camps at Morehead, and more than 2,200 students participated in Morehead summer programming at 33 community partner sites Morehead relaunched its monthly Carolina Science Café and Teen Science Café programs reaching hundreds of community members young and old

More than 260,000 people visited the Morehead website, and more than 32,000 people follow Morehead across 5 social media channels



NCSCIFEST

More than 100,000 people participated at 466 public events, and more than 53,000 people participated at 344 K-12 events

More than 40 of these events were attended by more than 500 people

NCSciFest was profiled on the NC STEM Explorers television program with a total viewership of over 300,000 Partners and participants embraced the 2023 theme—Full STEAM Ahead

877 events were held across the state reaching all 100 North Carolina counties

Morehead hosted three signature events: UNC Science Expo, Science for All Summit, and STEMville Science Spectacular More than 79,400 people visited the NCSciFest website, and more than 16,200 people follow NCSciFest across 3 social media channels
